ARCHITECTURE AND URBAN DESIGN: CONTEMPORARY RESEARCH

The conference is hosted by the Faculty of Architecture CTU in Prague on Thursday 7th December 2017, side events are going to follow on Friday 8th.

The conference is thematically focussed on various topics of architecture and urbanism from the perspective of the 21st century. Its goal is to improve the quality of architectural research and strengthen mutual cooperation among individuals and departments involved.

The conference will enable mutual comparison and expert review of research results of doctoral students mainly from FA and FSV CTU (ČVUT) in Prague, FA VUT in Brno, FA STU in Bratislava and other central European schools of architecture. Conference papers (in the extent of 7200 – 10 800 characters) will be expert reviewed and published in conference proceedings (in hardcopy and online on <http://kolokvium.fa.cvut.cz/>).

By submission, the authors agree to announce their email address in conference proceedings as well as with the publication of the conference paper on the aforementioned webpage and in the conference proceedings. Authors also guarantee that the submitted paper is original and wasn't published before.

Presentation format:

Each verbal presentation should be 10 minutes maximum, supplemented by a slideshow. The advised format of the slideshow is PPTX, PDF or JPG. The estimated number of presenters: 20. Each presentation will be followed by a 10-minute discussion.
